Meeting Notes

- 1) **Welcome & Roll Call** (Hibah Qudsi, MITRE) 5 minutes
 - 46 attendees
 - 37 announced in attendance

- 2) **Branding Update** (Hibah Qudsi, MITRE) 5 minutes
 - "Project PACIO"
 - The leadership team shared the link to the Project PACIO GitHub repository: <https://github.com/paciowg/Project-PACIO>
 - The leadership team is developing a website (ProjectPACIO.org) and logo

- 3) **IG Demo** (Chris Klesges & Tim Shaffer, MITRE) 25 minutes
 - See slide deck, "IMPACT FHIR IG Intro Presentation"
 - Chris & Tim provided a demo of the HAPI FHIR server
 - IG will allow for further constraining of cardinality
 - The resources are generally the "max possible" but allow for drilling down to specific observations
 - The hybrid structure allows users to locate an assessment by searching the questionnaire under which it may be classified
 - CMS has engaged MITRE to develop an IG and an accompanying reference implementation for the DEL
 - One participant inquired about how the group can make this applicable and/or what the expectations are of group members
 - Project PACIO is charged with identifying use cases and determining if current resources exist and/or if it is necessary to add extensions or develop an entirely new resource

- This would be further detailed by the IG and an accompanying reference implementation
- Participants expressed interest in reviewing the slide deck and meeting recording
- The leadership team walked through the anticipated timeline, from use case identification to the September Connectathon
- The reference implementation is what Project PACIO anticipates validating at the September Connectathon
- IG development typically requires 4-8 weeks
 - Reference implementation development timeline can vary depending on complexity

4) Use Case Overview (Dave Hill, MITRE) 25 minutes

- See slide deck, “Project Pacio Patient Persona”
- The leadership team asked participants to identify any missing pieces from the “Patient Story” slide
- The leadership team asked participants to share any comments/concerns about the Advance Directive use case that was presented
- The leadership team plans to share an additional use case around functional status on next week’s call
- Participants discussed focusing on an area of AD that is independent of state-to-state variations OR choose a state with minimal variation
- Several participants indicated there are existing solutions that address this use case already (i.e. MyDirectives)
 - Project PACIO has an opportunity to add value to existing solutions from a FHIR perspective
 1. Many existing solutions are exchanging health information through unstructured data (PDF, DIRECT messages, HL7 v2, etc.)
 2. Rather than trying to compete with existing AD vendors by developing a new solution, Project PACIO could create FHIR resources that these vendors/organizations can leverage to address AD exchange concerns in a computable way
- The leadership team encouraged participants to email with additional thoughts about this use case, including information about current standards supporting AD (CCDA, FHIR, etc.)
- The WG will continue this discussion at the next meeting
