1) Functional Status Technical Discussion (Chis Pugliese, Brightree)

- "BasedOn" field was discussed with the possibility of using a Questionnaire response, Device Request and Service Request
- Group should note that FHIR Resource names are not a literal translation of their function.

2) Leadership Updates (Dave Hill, MITRE)

- VOLUNTEERS NEEDED:
 - Technical Developers to develop Functional Status & Cognitive Status IGs
 - EHR Vendors to test reference implementations for the Functional Status & Cognitive Status IGs
 - Clinical SMEs to serve on the Interdisciplinary Clinical Advisory Group
- Project Scope Statement (PSS) approved by the Patient Care WG for the May 2020 ballot. Group made aware of the PSS being a non-binding agreement.
- CMS is hosting a connectathon in January, which is a great opportunity to test the reference implementations



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- The next HL7 Connectathon is in Sydney, Australia. Participants were asked to contact leadership team if there is interest in becoming a track lead.
- Need 3 different implementations
