Summary

- 1) **Leadership Update** (Siama R. and Dave H., MITRE) (30 mins)
 - MITRE provided an update on the Gravity Project and Care Coordination work.
 - Bob Dieterle has taken over the development of the Gravity Project Implementation Guide (IG) and Connectathon planning from Lisa Nelson.
 - Bi-directional services eReferral was removed from the Gravity Project IG and is no longer pursuing a partner for that work.
 - MITRE provided an overview of the system diagram.
 - September 2020 Connectathon scope
 - The HL7 September 2020 Connectathon will be held virtually on Wednesday September 9, 2020 through Friday September 11, 2020.
 - MITRE reviewed the goals for the upcoming Connectathon and three potential ideas to pursue: Integrate Bidirectional Services eReferral (BSeR); Subscription Support; and Documentation Requirement Lookup Service (DRLS).
 - The group agreed it would be beneficial to consider moving forward with the Subscription Support and Documentation Requirement Lookup Service (DRLS) for the 2020 Connectathon.
 - The group continued to discuss potential new use-cases.
 - One PACIO member recommended developing a use-case that would follow a patient with a cognitive deficit across settings. The use case would demonstrate how conducting a cognitive screen on a patient would trigger a full cognitive assessment.



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- This group agreed this use case would demonstrate how the information from a comprehensive cognitive assessment could travel with the patient and suggested including it in the September 2020 Connectathon.
- Guest speaker, Becky Gradl, from the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics, provided an overview of the Nutrition Working Group and their current projects.
- The Nutrition Working Group has developed two nutrition resources: Nutrition Product and Nutrition Intake. The nutrition resources are the equivalent of both medication resources: Medication Administration and Medication Usage. Both nutrition resources were approved in June 2020 as FHIR R5 resources.
- The Nutrition Working Group is currently in process of updating the nutrition domain analysis model, to reflect the broader scope of all nutrition and working to develop a FHIR Nutrition IG, for ballot in 2021, to provide dieticians a guidelines for data exchange.
- The group discussed collaborating with the Nutrition Working Group and will need to further discuss the needs in Post-Acute Care regarding nutrition.
- Becky agreed to participate in future PACIO meetings to discuss ongoing collaboration.
