## Summary

- 1) **Leadership Update** (Dave H., Siama R., MITRE) (25 mins)
  - Balloting Update:
    - The notice of intent to ballot for both PACIO IGs were rejected for the September HL7 Connectathon because appropriate HL7 approvals were missing.
    - PACIO leadership received the appropriate approvals and both IGs are accepted into the October 2020 out-of-cycle HL7 ballot.
    - Refer to slide 3 of the meeting materials for further information on the out-of-cycle ballot timeline.
  - HL7 September Connectathon Update:
    - HL7 is holding a virtual connectathon on September 9-11, 2020, with 36 tracks. PACIO is participating in 3 of these tracks:
      1. The PACIO-eLTSS PAC Transition Summary Track (<https://confluence.hl7.org/display/FHIR/2020-09+PACIO-eLTSS+Post-Acute+Care+Transition+Summary>) builds on the May 2020 HL7 Connectathon PACIO use case and includes more patient data, care coordination apps, and authenticated endpoints.
      2. The Clinical Reasoning Track (<https://confluence.hl7.org/display/FHIR/2020-09+Clinical+Reasoning>) will show an application of the PACIO-eLTSS PAC transition of functional and cognitive patient data to assess quality of care. This track will generate sample data to calculate quality measures.
      3. The Care Coordination Track (<https://confluence.hl7.org/display/FHIR/2020->

09+Care+Coordination+Track) will focus on multiple chronic conditions in eCare plans, specifically reducing BMI and use of narcotics for pain management. The Care Coordination team will access and include PACIO data in their use case.

- The leadership team updated the group on the PACIO use case and architecture diagram that will be presented during the September Connectathon. This information was reviewed in further detail during the track orientation webinar on August 26<sup>th</sup>. Refer to slides 5 and 6 of the meeting materials for further information.
  - The Co-Chair of the Patient Care Workgroup invited the PACIO workgroup to a series of discussions regarding appropriate use of data elements in the clinical workflow, level of burden, and ways to improve FHIR clinical resources. - PACIO Presentation Updates: The leadership team discussed the six convening opportunities between June and August, to date, that they participated in and presented PACIO work. There are 2 additional opportunities in late August. Refer to slide 7 of the meeting materials for further information about these presentations.
  - Present and Potential Future Use Cases
    - The PACIO Functional Status and Cognitive Status IGs are currently in STU1 ballot prep, and the application of quality measures in the use case is in development.
    - The leadership team discussed six additional future use case opportunities currently under review by the weekly workgroup members. Refer to slide 8 in the meeting materials for the full list of future use cases. A few key points regarding the future use cases discussed during this meeting include:
      1. The potential to address real-time issues using the PACIO IGs, such as post-COVID long-term side effects.
      2. The opportunities to include advance directive care in the use case and the level of involvement from other workgroups.
      3. Confirmation of communication between PACIO and the Gravity project regarding social determinants of health to ensure the PAC perspective is included.
      4. Outreach to the National Outcomes Measurement System (NOMS) team with the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA) to assess their interest in collaborating with PACIO. ASHA is in the early stages of identifying essential data elements in speech pathology documentation and is creating LOINC codes for these elements. PACIO will continue to collaborate with ASHA.
