Summary

1) Leadership Update (Dave H., and Siama R. MITRE)

- New Use Cases:
 - Email Siama (rizvi@mitre.org) by close of business Friday, October 9th to self-nominate or nominate others to lead the Advance Directive or Speech-Language Pathology use case work. PACIO leadership will begin interviewing those interested the week of October 12th.
 - PACIO Leadership met with the HL7 Community-based Care and Privacy (CBCP) Workgroup on September 6th to discuss the Speech-Language Pathology use case. CBCP reviewed the project proposal but requested to review the project scope statement prior to voting on sponsorship.
- Functional and Cognitive Status IG Ballot Update:
 - The leadership team submitted the final draft of content to HL7 on October 1st. The HL7 Patient Care Workgroup will meet to approve the content on October 12th and the final ballot content will be delivered to HL7 on October 15th.
 - The ballot comment period begins on October 20th and closes on November 20th.
 - Ballot reconciliation begins on November 20th and continues until the workgroup has received at least a 60% affirmative vote for approval of the IGs.
 - HL7 will provide the PACIO workgroup with comments in an excel spreadsheet. A subgroup of the PACIO workgroup will convert the comments into JIRA tickets and begin reconciling the negative votes and affirmative votes with comments.



PACIO

- The subgroup will present the reconciled issues first to the larger PACIO workgroup for input, and then to the Patient Care Workgroup in a “block vote” format to review and approve.
- PACIO Meeting Updates:
 - The leadership team will revise the weekly meeting invite title name to reflect the full scope of work the PACIO project is completing and will add additional content to Confluence as well.

2) Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Tools Crosswalk Volunteer Request (Kenneth Harwood)

- Kenneth briefly reviewed a crosswalk developed by the HL7 HCBS workgroup. The crosswalk compares Functional Assessment Standardized Items (FASI) against other commonly used functional assessment tools to highlight similarities and differences in tool purposes, areas of assessment, items in each domain, feasibility of use, quality reporting, interoperability, and various other qualitative comparisons.
- The HCBS workgroup will add 5-7 additional tools to the crosswalk and will disseminate it for comment prior to adding the crosswalk to the CMS website.
- PACIO workgroup members interested in continuing to this discussion and assisting with brainstorming additional variables to include in the comparison can contact Kenneth (kharwood@marymount.edu) to be added to the meeting.

3) Advance Directives Update (Maria Moen)

- Maria confirmed this work now has an HL7 workgroup sponsor and co-sponsor:
 - Patient Empowerment Workgroup voted to sponsor the Advance Directive use case on October 1st.
 - Community-Based Care and Privacy Workgroup voted to co-sponsor the work on October 6th.
- Maria has presented to various other HL7 workgroups, which expressed interest in following this work but have decided not to sponsor or co-sponsor PACIO at this time. Maria encouraged these workgroup members to join the PACIO weekly calls.

4) Walk-On Topics

- CMS encouraged interested workgroup members to register (<http://cpievents.cvent.com/events/pcg-provider-compliance-focus-group/event-summary-bd1c96cee473453791a3543e0744c1ec.aspx>) for the October 19th, Provider Compliance Focus Group (PCG). The PCG is an interactive session hosted by CMS to request feedback from stakeholders on medical review and prior authorization. Registration closes on October 13th.
