Summary

1) **Advance Directive Use Case** (Maria Moen, AD Vault, Inc.)

- Maria shared a draft visual representation of the four proposed use cases and relevant advance directive (AD) content to be included in each use case.
 - The four proposed use cases are:
 1. Create and share AD content
 2. Update and share AD content
 3. Request and access AD content
 4. Verify current version of AD content
 - The AD content proposed for inclusion within each use case is:
 1. AD information
 2. Episodic patient instruction
 3. Portable medical order for life-sustaining treatments
- The PACIO workgroup provided positive feedback on the proposed use cases and content.
- A few workgroup members noted that current AD content is well defined by clinicians and by states. However, there is variation in content between states due to a lack of federal standards. Maria offered to begin gathering existing AD content data from sources such as the clinical document architecture (CDA) and state forms to determine whether there are existing data sets for ADs and where there are similarities or differences in requirements.
- The PACIO workgroup will continue to use the standing weekly meetings to discuss the AD use case until the end of November when the Functional and Cognitive Assessment IG Ballot process ends. At that time, the workgroup will reassess the need for a separate meeting time to focus on this work.



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2) Restructuring FHIR Resources for PAC (Chris Pugliese, Matrix Care)

- Chris led a brainstorming session with the workgroup to dive deeper into which resources would support an “Assessment Time Point” HL7 FHIR profile.
- The workgroup agreed it is important to consider how this profile may impact multiple payers, not just Medicare. Many data points that feed into the development of the FHIR profile, such as observations, coverage, assessment completions, or case management, are driven by varying payer requirements.
- Chris will incorporate the workgroup’s feedback into his visual and continue this discussion during the next PACIO workgroup meeting.

3) Walk-on Items

- Rob Samples offered to walk through the HL7 balloting process during the next PACIO workgroup meeting.
- PACIO leadership is continuing to meet with the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA) to discuss collaboration opportunities for the Speech-Language Pathology use case.
