Summary

1) Leadership Update (Dave H., Siama R., MITRE)

- The PACIO Confluence page, the HL7 conference call calendar, and Outlook now reflect the updated meeting series for the weekly and monthly PACIO meetings. Email Leah Allen (lallen@mitre.org) if you have not received the new meeting series in Outlook and would like to be included on the invite.
- Balloting Updates:
 - The voting period closed on November 20th and PACIO leadership continues to group and prioritize the comments received on the Functional Status and Cognitive Status IGs.
 - The PACIO workgroup will discuss substantive comments and vote on proposed action plans. Once approved by the PACIO workgroup, PACIO leadership will present comments and proposed resolutions to the sponsoring workgroup, the HL7 Patient Care Workgroup.
 - The HL7 Patient Care Workgroup will make the final decision on whether to implement proposed changes to the IGs. PACIO leadership will share the sponsoring workgroup's decision with the PACIO workgroup.
 - PACIO will update the continuous integration build of the IGs after approval by the sponsoring workgroup.
- Connectathon Update:
 - PACIO is hosting the PACIO-eLTSS Post-Acute Care Transition Summary Track webinar during the December 16th PACIO Weekly Meeting. A recording of the webinar will be posted on Confluence

- PACIO leadership reviewed the updated use case and emphasized six updates to systems within the architecture:
 1. eCQM System: Patient Centric Solutions and the HL7 Clinical Reasoning Track are working with PACIO to demonstrate how data will be pulled and used to calculate eCQMs to satisfy CMS quality program requirements.
 2. Advance Directives System: MaxMD and ADVault are collaborating with PACIO to exchange basic advance directive information.
 3. Health Information Exchange: The Michigan Health Information Network (MiHIN) is supplying a “sandbox” server to demonstrate an exchange of data between an Health Information Network and the Health Data Manager.
 4. Authentication/Identification Server: Patient Centric Solutions and ID.me are assisting with patient matching and will lead a session during the Connectathon on identification management, including using open technologies as a basis for consent.
 5. CMS Pseudo iQIES: CMS and PACIO are developing a FHIR API prototype to test the exchange of PAC assessments between PAC providers and CMS.
 6. HHA EHR: MatrixCare is replacing the pseudo-EHR used during the September Connectathon with their own EHR system.
- Registration for the January 2021 HL7 Connectathon is open, and early bird registration with a discounted rate ends on December 30, 2020. If you are interested in participating, additional information is available on Confluence <https://confluence.hl7.org/display/FHIR/2021-01+Connectathon+26>).
- Advance Directives Use Case Update:
 - The HL7 Patient Empowerment Workgroup is sponsoring PACIO’s Advance Directive Information (ADI) use case. Three HL7 workgroups have agreed to co-sponsor this work: Community-Based Care and Privacy, Patient Care, and Orders and Observations.
 - Various workgroups and organizations must approve the ADI Project Scope Statement (PSS) prior to the May HL7 Ballot process in order for PACIO to participate:
 1. US Realm approved the ADI PSS on 10/27/2020
 2. FHIR Management Group approved the ADI PSS on 10/28/2020.
 3. The Administrative Steering Division approved the ADI PSS on 12/15/2020

4. The Technical Steering Committee is scheduled to e-vote on the ADI PSS by 12/27/2020.

- PACIO leadership briefly reviewed the ADI use cases currently in development. Refer to slides 7-8 in the 2020-12-16 PACIO Monthly Meeting PowerPoint materials for additional information.
- Assessment Timepoint Update:
 - The PACIO workgroup identified an issue with the FHIR Encounter and Episode of Care Resources. The Resources better align with acute care definitions than PAC since PAC includes more long-term care that may involve multiple treatments from multiple providers on a concurrent timeline.
 - Members of the PACIO workgroup meet and discuss developing a potential Care Coordination Resource that will map encounters and episodes of care in the PAC setting. Refer to slides 9-10 in the 2020-12-16 PACIO Monthly Meeting PowerPoint materials for additional information.
