This working group is a public forum and therefore all information shared will be publicly available.

Summary

1) **Functional Status** (Dave H., MITRE) (60 mins)

Group continued to finalize the 4 functional data element areas:

- Prior Level of Function
 - Since there is no standard for clinicians to determine the prior level of function, for STU1 clinicians will be able specify details in a free text field
 - If a prior assessment is not available, a document reference will be provided - a document reference provides better structure and more context than an open text field
- Risks and Precautions
 - Group is considering leveraging the eLTSS list of condition resources
 - If there is a health condition that is not covered on the extensible list, PACIO could propose a new category to be added, without requiring approval
 - Group recommended including codes that are not currently on the list for items essential for both PAC and Home and Community Based Care
- List of Equipment Needed
 - Group will need to review the “FHIR device type” value set to determine if this list would serve as a good resource
 - Group also will review the Functional Assessment Standardized Items (FASI), LOINC, and the Unique Device Identifier codes for equipment



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- Group recommended using FASI/LOINC equipment codes for STU1 and adding additional items over time, in addition to including SNOMED codes when available
- Group agreed to review the FHIR device type list to determine the best code set
- Instrumental Activities for Daily Living
 - Group is considering leveraging the FASI to identify aspects of daily living items; eLTSS resource to identify pain items; and vital sign resource to identify vital sign observations
 - Members recommended considering other coding options, as the FASI does not provide enough detail for PAC
 - Group will review the International Classification of Functioning, Disability, and Health ICF (classification of function) and the BARTHEL index (for ADLs) as an alternative to FASI

2) Cognitive Status (Rob S., ESAC) (25 mins)

- Group discussed including the Federal requirements for Pre-Admission Screening and Resident Review (PASRR) screening test among the other cognitive assessment screenings
 - Each state has its own version of PASRR, which would make it challenging to add to the cognitive data model
 - The group agreed the PASRR should not be added to the cognitive assessment list at this time, as it may not provide meaningful information

3) CMS Updates (Beth C., CMS) (5 mins)

- The FASI items are now available in the DEL - FASI tests standardized items for home and community-based services
- LOINC codes for FASI items will be released in June 2020
- The DEL also will feature a new search feature to the webpage in May 2020, allowing users to easily search for items
