## Summary

### 1) Connectathon Preparation (Dave H. and Siama R., MITRE)

- The HL7 Connectathon will be hosted virtually from May 13-15, 2020, with 34 tracks presented
- PACIO submitted two track proposals:
  - PACIO-eLTSS PAC Care Transition Summary Track
  - PACIO participating as part of the Coordinated Care Track
  - PACIO will test both the Cognitive and Functional Status IG in both tracks
- PACIO has updated each IG to questionnaire/questionnaire response from the bundled observation
  - Questionnaire/Questionnaire response captures the information and adds it to the form. This will allow users to put the questions in the correct order to build out the assessment
  - Users will be able to query information as well
- PACIO currently is working on developing a PAC assessment application, to share patient information across EHR systems
- Connectathon Timeline:
  - April 3: Track proposals due
  - April 10: IG guide draft complete
  - April 17: Sample data complete
  - May 5: Reference IG complete and hosted, test scripts complete, and continue debugging
  - May 13-15: HL7 virtual connectathon

# PACIO

- PACIO has put together a use case team to build a combined PACIO and eLTSS use case, focusing on the transition of care
- MITRE provided an overview of the use case developed for the May connectathon, showcasing the exchange of data, as the patient moves across PAC settings
- Next steps: Developing sample data for the use case
- MITRE presented the proposed architecture, which highlights how each agency would share data across systems, as well as the items PACIO is currently working on (blue arrows) and items we are working towards the future (dotted arrows)

## 2) Functional Status Update (Dave H., MITRE)

- Group has worked to gain consensus on what the functional data model should be
- 4 key functional data element areas
  1. Prior level of function
    - Condition before the current episode or exacerbation
    - Since there is no standard for clinicians to determine the prior level of function, for STU1 clinicians will be able specify details in a free text field
    - PACIO will continue to explore options to refine prior level of function standards for STU2
  2. List of risks and precautions
    - Group agreed to provide a risk and precautions list rather than categorizing the items
  3. Equipment
    - List of equipment items the patient might need
    - PACIO is considering using Functional Assessment Standardized Items (FASI) items and looking at what has already been used in FHIR for “equipment”.
  4. Instrumental aspects of daily living
    - PACIO is considering leveraging the FASI to identify aspects of daily living items

## 3) Cognitive Status Update (Dave H., MITRE)

- Group has considered various screening tests for what to capture in the data model, some of which will be tested at the connectathon

## 4) CMS Updates (Beth C., CMS)

- The FASI items are now available in the DEL - FASI tests standardized items for home and community-based services
- LOINC codes for FASI items will be released in June 2020



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- The DEL also will feature a new search feature to the webpage in May 2020, allowing users to easily search for items
