Summary

1) Leadership Update (Dave Hill and Siama Rizvi)

- January HL7 Connectathon:
 - PACIO leadership informed the work group about the issues documented during the January HL7 Connectathon and shared the notable achievements accomplished. PACIO's track successfully exchanged data between more than 15 systems using 4 FHIR Implementation Guides, demonstrated the use of Structure Data Capture to submit CMS PAC assessments for quality reporting purposes, and demonstrated the import of current data from a health information exchange into the data manager.

 - PACIO leadership asked all work group members who participated in the Connectathon to email Siama Rizvi (rizvi@mitre.org) or Leah Allen (lallen@mitre.org) with their experiences, feedback, and suggestions for improving engagement of both technical and non-technical participants in future Connectathons. PACIO leadership will use this feedback to write an open letter to HL7 with recommendations to consider for the next Connectathon.
- HL7 Work Group Meetings: PACIO leadership participated in various HL7 Working Group Meetings during the week of January 25, 2021 and shared an overview of those meetings with the PACIO work group.



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- The Community Based Care and Privacy HL7 Work Group expressed interest in sponsoring the Reassessment Timepoint work once the Project Scope Statement is complete and available for review.
- The HL7 Working Groups discussed FHIR vocabulary and infrastructure, including aligning value sets and code systems across multiple IGs, and how to properly incorporate proprietary code systems into an IG.
- The HL7 Working Groups also discussed aligning the publishing tools between FHIR and CDA standards.

2) Advance Directive Use Case Update (Maria Moen)

- For the May HL7 Connectathon, the ADI FHIR IG use case will focus on person-authored advance directive information, with a goal of submitting the use case for STU1 ballot in May 2021.

3) Cognitive Function IG Ballot Reconciliation (Sean Mahoney)

- A subset of PACIO work group members continues to meet weekly to resolve the issues documented during the ballot process. The Block Vote 1 proposed dispositions reviewed and approved during the January 27, 2021 PACIO weekly meeting were shared with the Patient Care HL7 Work Group, which will vote on approving Block Vote 1 during their February 8, 2021 meeting.
- The PACIO work group discussed potential resolutions for the profile issue for Prior Level of Cognitive Function. Suggested dispositions include:
 - Providing additional direction on or examples of what may be included in the codeable concept field. Examples may be included in the IG or in a supplemental guide.



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- Incorporating binding and including LOINC codes, however, the must support flag would have to be removed in order to support example binding.
- Assigning use cases to each definition to help clinicians identify appropriate content to include in the profile.
- Adding a reference field to previous encounters to create a computable way of transmitting the Prior Level of Cognitive Function data.

4) Speech-Language Pathology Use Case Update (Jamila Harley)
