## Summary

### 1) Leadership Update (Dave H., Siama R., MITRE)

#### - HL7 Activities

##### • HL7 January Connectathon Update:

1. The PACIO-eLTSS Transition Summary Track successfully exchanged data between 15+ systems utilizing 5 FHIR Implementation Guides, introduced advance directive information exchange into the use case, and demonstrated use of Structured Data Capture to submit CMS PAC assessments for quality reporting purposes.
2. PACIO leadership reviewed screenshots of the successful data exchanges and discussed issues identified during the Connectathon, including difficulty confirming the hospital posting QuestionnaireResponse to the data hub and mapping LOINC codes to the Data Element Library codes.
3. The PACIO work group will continue to reach out to IT implementors to add real-world systems into the use case to replace the reference implementations and will continue to develop and incorporate the advance directives information use case.

- HL7 January Work Group Meeting: PACIO leadership participated in various HL7 work group meetings during the last week of January and presented PACIO updates.

#### - Use Case Updates

##### • Functional Status and Cognitive Status:

1. A subgroup of the PACIO work group meets weekly to review and resolve the 49 comments on the Functional



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Status Ballot and the 48 comments on the Cognitive Status ballot.

2. The subgroup submitted Block Vote 1, a package of 13 Cognitive Status dispositions, to the HL7 Patient Care Work Group, which approved them on February 8, 2021.
  3. The subgroup continues to prepare the Cognitive Status Block Vote 2 package and plans to submit it to the HL7 Patient Care Work Group by March 1, 2021.
- Advance Directive Information (ADI):
    1. A subgroup of the PACIO work group meets weekly to further define and develop the ADI use case, led by Maria Moen from AdVault. Maria shared the potential ADI use cases and content types that the subgroup considered, and confirmed the subgroup is focusing on Content Area 1: Person-Authored Advance Directive Information.
    2. The subgroup is starting an environmental scan to identify existing paper-based advance directive information and existing value sets and will use that information to identify gaps and develop an IG for STU1 ballot.
  - Reassessment Timepoints:
    1. The HL7 Community-Based Care and Privacy Work Group approved the Project Scope Statement (PSS) on February 9, 2021 and agreed to sponsor this use case, led by Chris Pugliese from MatrixCare. The HL7 Program Management Office is currently review the PSS and Project Proposal.
    2. A subgroup of the PACIO work group meets weekly to determine how to add capabilities to the Encounter and Episode of Care Resources to capture PAC reassessment timepoints for patients who may have multiple providers across an extended period of time.
  - Speech Language Pathology: Jamila Harley from the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA) leads this use case, and is working to develop the Project Proposal and PSS.
