Leadership Update (Dave Hill, MITRE)

- 2) Dave Hill gave an overview and background about the PACIO Project including the project's history and purpose.
- 3) PACIO Leadership reviewed the existing Use Cases and updated the group on their status of development.
 - Functional and Cognitive Status Ballot Reconciliation Update
 - PACIO Leadership described the overall balloting process.
 - Block Vote 3 package of dispositions will be submitted 3/22/2021 to the Patient Care Work Group.
 - Advanced Directives Interoperability (ADI) Update
 - The initial content focus area is person authored information about their advanced directive information (vs. practitioner authored).
 - Five ADI use cases and a high-level overview of the content for the FHIR IG was shared with the group.
 - The ADI Track Proposal for the HL7 May 2021 Connectathon will be submitted by March 23.
 - The Connectathon Minimum Viable Product will include two scenes focusing on: (1) creating a directive, storing it in a system, pushing it to another system, and (2) querying the directive information to display results (use cases 1-3).

PACIO

- The project goal is to profile the encounter and/or the episode of care resource to create definition for sub-periods of time within an extended post-acute admission (PAC).
 - The Community-Based Care and Privacy Work Group approved the Project Scope Statement (PSS) on 2/9/21 and Patient Care Work Group agreed to co-sponsor on 2/22/21. Patient Administration Work Group wishes to be an interested party (3/10/21).
 - The use case lead currently is working to obtain additional necessary PSS HL7 approvals.
 - Current focus is on developing a data model for profiles and extensions focusing on Encounter and Clinical Impression resources.
- Speech, Language, Cognitive Communication, Hearing and Swallowing Update
 - The title was updated from “Speech Language Pathology” to broaden the scope of data exchanged and to focus more on the patient’s information and less on any types of professionals contributing the information.
 - The use case lead has submitted the Project Proposal into HL7 Jira and will begin the process of identifying a sponsoring workgroup as well as starting to draft the Project Scope Statement (PSS).
