2) Review of Use Cases.

- Functional and Cognitive Status Ballot Reconciliation Update
  - The team submitted Block Vote 4 dispositions to the Patient Care Work Group for approval at the April 26 meeting.
  - The team is currently working on Block Vote 5 dispositions and the Cognitive Status dispositions are almost complete.
- Advanced Directives Interoperability (ADI) Update
  - The team is working on the data adjudication process from the environmental scan of advance directive forms across the United States.
  - The technical team continues to draft the FHIR Implementation Guide (IG)

- Reassessment Timepoint Update
  - The project goal is to profile the encounter and/or the episode of care resource(s) to create definition for sub-periods of time within an extended post-acute admission (PAC).
  - HL7 US Realm Committee approved the Project Scope Statement on April 6.
  - The team continues to build the data model.
  - The group discussed the benefits and limitations associated with profiling the Clinical Impression Resource versus the Encounter

Resource and determined the Encounter Resource was the better choice.

- PACIO will focus on this use case for the July 2021 CMS Connectathon.

## - **Speech, Language, Swallowing, Cognitive Communication, and Hearing (SPLASCH) Update**

- PACIO decided to rename the use case previously referred to as Speech Language Pathology. The new acronym “SPLASCH,” stands for **S**peech, **L**anguage, **S**wallowing, **C**ognitive **C**ommunication, and **H**earing.
- The HL7 community expressed support for the SPLASCH Project Proposal and the team currently is working to identify an HL7 sponsor.
  1. The Community Based Care & Privacy Work Group expressed interest in sponsoring or co-sponsoring, but suggested the Patient Care Work Group might be the most appropriate sponsor since they have greater subject matter expertise on this topic.
  2. Jamila Harley will present the Project Scope Statement (PSS) on April 26 to the Patient Care Work Group for approval and possible sponsorship or co-sponsorship.
