(Speech, Language, Swallowing, Cognitive Communication, and Hearing)

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- The subgroup shared their progress in the development of the use case and data model outline using the International Classification of Functioning, Disability and Health (ICF) model as a framework.

3) Advance Directive Interoperability (ADI) Update (Corey Spears and Maria Moen)

 - The goal of STU1 is to transmit a snapshot in time by sending the bundle, which is comprised of:
 1. Entry References
 2. Healthcare Agent
 3. Goals, Preferences, and Priorities (GPP) for Quality of Life
 4. End of Life or Emergency Intervention Preferences
 5. GPP for Upon Death
 6. Administrative Information
 - The ADI use case lead shared the ADI Project Diagram detailing the bundle, its sections, and the content included within each section. The diagram is available for review on Confluence:

 - The server deconstructs each section from the ADI document to ensure each concept is communicated through data exchange without a section reference limiting how it's communicated. Maria shared an example from the adjudication spreadsheet comparing two forms. One form includes questions about autopsy preferences in the Healthcare Agent section and the other form includes autopsy preferences in the End of Life section. The subgroup decided that transmitting snapshots in time of the bundle best maintains authenticity with where information is captured and communicates the concepts without limiting data.
- The ADI use case lead shared a Coalition to Transform Advanced Care (C-TAC) news article highlighting PACIO's advance directive work.
- PACIO leadership reviewed the ADI balloting process timeline and deadlines:
 - To participate in the September 2021 ballot process, the Patient Empowerment Work Group must approve the Notice of Intent to Ballot by June 24 and submit by July 4.



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- If the September 2021 ballot is not feasible, the next ballot cycle is in January 2022, although the team may have an opportunity to participate in an early ballot in October.
- PACIO Leadership presented the outstanding ADI Major Tasks including estimated work effort, expected benefit, and whether each item is a “must do” for a STU-1 ballot.

4) Re-assessment Timepoints Update (Chris Pugliese)

- The Reassessment Timepoints Subgroup Leadership met on June 16 to finalize the draft IG (<https://paciowg.github.io/re-assessment-timepoints-ig/>) and will review the draft IG in more detail with the PACIO Weekly members on June 23. The goal is to finalize the IG over the next two weeks and present it during the July CMS Connectathon.
