2) SPLASCH Update (Jamila Harley)

(Speech, Language, Swallowing, Cognitive Communication, and Hearing)

- The SPLASCH sub-group met August 10 to discuss the Project Scope Statement (PSS) and PACIO feedback on revisions to Scene 2.

- Sub-group leadership met August 9 with the sponsoring Patient Care Work Group (PCWG) and on August 4 with the Community Based Care and Privacy (CBCP) Work Group (co-sponsor) to request approval of the Project Scope Statement (PSS).

 - The CBCP Work Group approved the PSS pending PCWG review and approval.
 - The PCWG provided feedback, specifically requesting revisions to the scope, which IGs may be referenced or updated, and clarification on the data elements to be exchanged.
 - The sub-group leadership will meet next week to review the feedback, revise the PSS, and will share the revisions with the PACIO contributors during an upcoming meeting.
- SPLASCH subgroup members continue to examine the Use Case persona to revise Scene 2. They shared their recent discussion and revisions with the larger PACIO community. The members have incorporated prior input from the PACIO community, including clinical pathways shared by acute care therapists.

3) Advance Directive Interoperability (ADI) Update (Tina Wilkins)

- ADI subgroup members continue to work through and improve data adjudication methods.
 - Changed the data adjudication tracker, to roll up individual form items into logical higher-level concepts.
 - Proposed grouping similar data during data adjudication to eliminate redundancies and determine which data are overly prescriptive.
 - Discussed an alternative approach for identifying condition specific directives with a value set to capture specific instructions by intervention instead of having a code for each concept.
- ADI Tech team is considering adding a Situational Care Plan to the Composition.



4) Functional Status Ballot Reconciliation (Caleb Wan)

- Block Vote 3 - Group 2 (Six Items)
 - The Tech Team presented and invited feedback on the following revisions to the Functional Status IG based on ballot comments:
 1. **FHIR-29737, Persuasive with modification:** Changed the profile name 'BundledFunctionalStatus' to 'FunctionalStatusCollection' to avoid confusion with the FHIR Bundle resource.
 2. **FHIR-30047, Persuasive:** Updated the Observation.code and Observation.value descriptions to provide further clarification on their meanings and usages.
 3. **FHIR-29752, Persuasive with modification:** Changed the profile name 'Prior Level of Function' to 'Narrative History of Functional Status', and updated the profile description to explain when the profile should be used.
 4. **FHIR-29757, Persuasive:** Replaced 'US Core Observation Lab' for the 'Prior Level of Function' profile with the Observation resource. Observation.value will be used to store the summary of the observation, and a correct example showing the use of the Observation.value field has been added.
 5. **FHIR-29744, Persuasive with modification:** Removed the QuestionnaireResponse profile. The IG now provides guidance for using the SDCQuestionnaireResponse profile. Removed guidance for using QuestionnaireResponse.item.id to specify the question LOINC code.
 6. **FHIR 30019, Persuasive:** Clarified the principal physical location where the observation event occurred in the Observation.extension:event-location definition.
- Approval of Block Vote 3, Group 2
 - Caleb Wan motioned to approve the 6 items discussed today in Block Vote 3. Ken Hardwick seconded. The motion passed 21 - 0.

- The members approved 6 additional items in Functional Status Block Vote 3 for PACIO Leadership to present for approval at the next Patient Care Work Group meeting.
