## 2) Ballot Reconciliation Update (Caleb Wan)

- Patient Care Work Group (PCWG) approved (08/23/2021) the Functional Status Implementation Guide (IG) Block Vote 3 after the item FHIR-30047 was removed.
  - Members of Patient Care raised concerns regarding the resolution for FHIR-30047 and suggested we discuss with the Orders and Observations Work Group (OOWG). The leadership team met with OOWG to discuss a resolution but did not reach a conclusion.
  - Subgroup Leadership presented the issue concerning the FunctionalStatusCollection Profile. There are 2 options to present the summary score for structured assessments that have a summary score; Observation.value and Observaton.hasMember
    1. The OOWG recommended having the score at the collection level by using the value field, but indicated they would not require the change in order to ballot. If the IG moves forward without making this change, they indicated they would file a Jira ticket to flag this issue.

The PACIO community debated the recommendation and raised concerns about losing the score's meaning when there are multiple summary scores.

The PACIO community agreed that no change is needed; following the OOWG guidance would not allow the IG to support the exchange of multiple summary scores.

2. The OOWG recommended adding an extension using the Ordinal Value extension instead of using Quantity.

The PACIO community noted that scores will use different type of values based on the instrument and this recommendation seems too restrictive.

The group agreed to continue to use Quantity type and add additional guidance in the IG.

### 3) SPLASCH Update (Jamila Harley)

(Speech, Language, Swallowing, Cognitive Communication, and Hearing)

- SPLASCH sub-group met on 8/24/2021 to discuss and revise the Project Scope Statement (PSS).
  - The updated PSS is available on Confluence.

Changes to the PSS included:
    1. Updated language and added examples in the scope section to reflect International Classification of Functioning, Disability and Health (ICF) framework.
    2. Added details to tentative dates.
  - The group agreed to request time on upcoming Community Based Care and Privacy (CBCP) Work Group and Patient Care Work Group (PCWG) agendas, to request approval of the PSS within the next 2 weeks.
  - The goal is to have the PCWG submit the approved PSS to the PMO by October 8, 2021, to allow the option of participating in the HL7 May 2022 Connectathon.
- The subgroup continues to work on their clinical use cases and confirmed they will use PACIO's Betsy Smith-Johnson for the persona. A PACIO community member noted that the addition of this IG will fill-in much needed gaps in the patient story throughout transitions of care.
- A PACIO community member raised a concern about the IG being inclusive of multiple disciplines e.g., physical therapists, social workers, dieticians. The subgroup leadership confirmed the goal IG is intended to meet the needs of data exchange for interdisciplinary teams, not just speech language pathologists. The IG focuses on the functions and activities that are assessed and is not limited to any discipline. The team will update the language in the PSS for clarity.
- Attendees were invited to participate in SPLASCH subgroup work. The next meeting is September 7 from 3-4pm (EST).
