- sponsored and approved by the Patient Care Work Group during their [September 13, 2021 meeting](#)
- co-sponsored and approved by the Community-Based Care and Privacy Work Group during their [August 3, 2021 meeting](#) and [August 31, 2021 meeting](#) after minor PSS updates
- PSS entered into Project Insight, Project ID 1371 on Sept 16
- approved by FHIR Management Group during their [September 29 meeting](#)
- approved by USRC by e-vote during their [October 5 meeting](#) and sent to TSC
- Approved by TSC by e-vote, during the [October 18 meeting](#); requested that project name a vocabulary facilitator



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Date of SPLASCH Discussion: 10/19

Topic: continue drafting patient story; HL7 progress

- **Officially an HL7 project as of 10/18.**
- Becky Gradl recommended meeting with PCWG for ICF background and framework discussion. Meeting scheduled for 10/20, 5pm EST, Led by Matt Elrod, Jamila Harley, Dave Hill.
- Brian Meshell to slowly transition into Leah Allen's role with the Use Case group. Leah plans to transition out in November as we start the more technical aspects of the work.

Key Considerations Discussed:

- Discussed the relationship between ICF and FCM
- No existing diagram or description of the relationship between the ICF Model and FCMs. However, FCM assessments are informed by the ICF framework. With the FCMs, clinician answers questions based on their formal and/or informal assessment of the individual's performance: they consider body structures and function and any restrictions or limitations that may impact the individual's ability to participate in activities. The answers to the FCM questions as well as the PRO questions can assist clinicians with documenting the individual's functional status, specifically activities and participation, and help with treatment planning.
- No new updates on LOINCS requested for the FCM's. Sara Armson and Matt Becker to assist with moving approval process along.



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Key Considerations Discussed (cont'd)

- Clarified that to use LOINCS one does not have to NOMS certified, but will need some training in FCM.
- Continued drafting scene 3
