2) Leadership Update and Review of Use Cases (Dave Hill)

Skipped PACIO project overview because no new participants on the call, and to budget enough time to cover all PACIO use case updates

Topics covered include:

- PACIO Overview and Use Case Updates
 - **Speech, Language, Swallowing, Cognitive Communication, and Hearing (SPLASCH)**
 1. Continuing to define and prioritize ICF-based health domain categories
 2. May Connectathon prep: Added hearing and multi-modal communication profiles, generated sample data for these new profiles
 3. SPLASCH IG is under active development. First demoed at January 2022 Connectathon. Not yet in ballot. Targeting September 2022 or January 2023 for STU-1 ballot
 - **Advance Directive Information (ADI)**
 1. STU-1 person-authored information. Have gone through 2 block votes already. Working on dispositions for block vote
 3. Working on definition of “must support”

2. STU-2 practitioner-authored information. Continue working with adjudication spreadsheet. Portable medical orders for life-sustaining treatment (PMOLST)

- **Re-assessment Timepoints**

1. Currently working on block vote 2 ticket resolution: search parameters and combinations. Example: What defines the beginning of and end of a clinical timepoint, and who defines this?
2. Working on clearer sample data to avoid ambiguity. Refining search parameters and combinations.
3. May Connectathon prep: development of sample data.

- **Functional Status and Cognitive Status**

1. Published as STU-1 standards, targeting September ballot for STU-2.
2. Items for STU-2 consideration:
 - Should summary score be at the observation level, or a level above?
 - Tighter code systems and value sets. Currently references all of LOINC, which allows for nonsensical data. Looking to leverage Gravity to define categories/domains, each with their own code systems and value sets.
3. Initial ICF-based category list created. Proposed as a basis for an exploratory “Functional Performance” consolidated IG
4. Next steps: test the feasibility of the Functional Performance at the May Connectathon. Continue to define code systems and value sets.

- FHIR Dev Days (hybrid, June 6-9, 2022)
 - Hybrid event with Nancy Lush and Dave Hill presenting in-person in Cleveland, OH. Will present the work from May Connectathon.
- May HL7 Connectathon (virtual, May 2-4, 2022)
 - PACIO Integration Track. Three goals:
 1. Test new framework for cognitive status, functional status, potentially SPLASCH
 2. Continue to expand upon SPLASCH use case
 3. Focus on integration with other IGs: multiple chronic conditions e-care plan, electronic long term services and support (ELTSS), Gravity Social Determinants of Health (SDOH), Standard Personal Health Record (MITRE), clinical quality measuring w/ clinical reasoning track.
 - All are invited to join the planning during the Tech Team meetings on Thursdays (2-3pm ET), use case meetings Fridays (11:30am-12:30pm ET)

 - Test exchange of ADI practitioner-authored information
