2) PACIO Project Background (Dave Hill)

- Goal is for data to follow the Post-Acute care patient across the continuum of care.
- Post-Acute care patients have complex care journeys. Medical providers are reliant on patient recall, which can be inaccurate, especially in stressful situations. Results in poor outcomes, including inaccuracies in medications, repeating diagnostic tests.
- PACIO project created in 2019. Collaborative effort between industry, government, other stakeholders.
- PACIO project use cases:
 - Personal Functioning and Engagement (includes 3 observation-based PACIO implementation guides: Functional Status, Cognitive Status, SPLASCH.)
 - Advance Directives
 - Re-assessment Timepoints
 - Quality Measures

3) Leadership Update and Review of Use Cases (Dave Hill)

- **Personal Functioning and Engagement (PFE)**
 - Define healthcare domains; tie the healthcare domains to code systems and value sets.



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- The PFE implementation guide (IG) will be an innovation platform for future use cases. Instead of creating new IGs with profiles, we can add code systems and value sets to existing IG. Easier and more consistent for IG authors and client app implementers.
- The PACIO IGs for Cognitive Status, Functional Status, and SPLASCH will be rolled into the larger PFE IG.
- The name of this IG changed for several reasons:
 - “Functional Performance” was rejected because the word “Performance” has a specific meaning within ICF.
 - “Functioning” was rejected as too broad.
- Preparing Functional Performance and Engagement IG for September 2022 ballot.
- The SPLASCH project scope statement was enhanced to include PFE topics.
- Cognitive Status and Functional Status IGs are published as STU 1, will probably not proceed beyond STU 1 before being rolled into PFE.
- **Advance Directives (ADI)**
 - Maria Moen from AD Vault is use case lead.
 - STU-1 person-authored information across the 5 use cases (create, share, query, update, verify).
 - STU-2 practitioner-authored information focusing on type 3 (PMOLST) as opposed to type 2 (encounter-centric).
 - PACIO Tiger Team completed a terminology review with a goal to harmonize ADI (FHIR), CDA, and VSAC.
 - ADI will be the focus of July 2022 Connectathon. Will exchange STU-1 content and a scanned STU-2 portable medical order document.
 - Reviewed structural modeling approaches beginning with existing FHIR based Post-Acute Orders (focus on durable medical equipment/home health).
 - STU-2 environmental scan in progress.
 - Subgroup concluded there is value in capturing the practitioner role related to the patient.
- **Re-assessment Timepoints**
 - Chris Pugliese from Brightree is use case lead
 - Re-assessment Timepoint was created to break up long and potentially overlapping episodes of care between encounter and assessment.
 - This makes data more easily searchable. Also, sometimes required by regulation (example: provide updated every 60 days).
 - Finishing up STU-1 ballot reconciliation. Block vote 3 was approved by Community-Based Care and Privacy.
 - Targeting publication by September 2022.
- **July CMS Connectathon**
 - July 19-22, 2022 CMS Connectathon (virtual).



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- Test exchange of ADI practitioner-authored information zero cost to participate.
- Format will be different from previous Connectathons. Focused on three 20 minutes demo sessions.
- 3 day event
 - Day 1: CMS regulation and policy
 - Day 2: Track demo/testing (three 20 min sessions)
 - Day 3: Track highlights
