 - What is the form of that information? (e.g., observations, other?)
 - What code systems and value sets might apply?

- PACIO Leadership reviewed the think tank objective to explore how a common framework could allow for greater flexibility for more clinical domains without requiring multiple Implementation Guides (IGs).
- PACIO Leadership shared and requested feedback on a list of ICF Categories and subcategories to be used for Functional and Cognitive Status.
 - The group clarified a poll for prioritization would use a “high-medium-low” scale and consider the data from the patient’s perspective.
 - A Community member advised only considering higher level ICF categories (level 1, 2, or 3).
 - A Community member encouraged the group to focus on using what already exists in the Functional Status and Cognitive Status IG and apply the domain model.
 - PACIO Leadership will create a poll to determine the categories needed for Functional and Cognitive status; an accompanying spreadsheet will provide context to show the concept levels.
 - The group agreed to first focus on Body Function and Activities of Participation.
