- ADI leadership plans to clarify for the content domain experts on the Wednesday noon ADI subgroup calls more specifically what feedback would help drive the decisions for updates to the implementation guide (IG).

 - Tech team leadership provided a report out of the weekly subgroup meeting and encouraged the Community to visit the Confluence page at <https://confluence.hl7.org/display/PC/PACIO+Project+Re-assessment+Timepoints>.

 - Tech team leadership will seek additional guidance from the FHIR Infrastructure Workgroup on how to specify search parameter combination conformance requirements (no current consensus within the HL7 FHIR Community).
 - Leadership presented an overview of the Re-assessment Timepoints proposed dispositions for Block Vote 1 ballot reconciliation.
 - Ballot concerns focused on where terminology and value set content should be maintained.
 - Proposed disposition is “Considered for Future Use” since the IG and value sets contained within should be more mature before a final decision is made for repository location.
 - The community voted unanimously (26-0-0) to approve Block Vote 1 to be presented to the Community Based Care and Privacy Work Group in the upcoming weeks.

4) SPLASCH Update (Brian Meshell and Jamila Harley)

- (Speech, Language, Swallowing, Cognitive Communication, and Hearing)

- Subgroup leadership reviewed:
 - Concepts in the International Classification of Functioning, Disability, and Health (ICF) will provide a structure to the framework, but subgroup leadership does not intend to use specific ICF codes at this time.
 - The group reached consensus to create and distribute within the subgroup a poll to help determine the prioritization of the concepts for data exchange. The prioritization can help guide the order of concept exploration to determine if additional profile types would be needed (e.g., based on resources other than Observation).

- PACIO Leadership reviewed the think tank objective to explore how a common framework could allow for greater flexibility for more clinical domains without requiring multiple Implementation Guides (IGs).
- The group discussed different ways to think about priority other than just along the concepts of high, medium, low (1st, 2nd, 3rd) including conceptualizing priority based on transitions of care (i.e., what should be communicated in a transfer summary).
- The Community recognized other considerations for decision making including the level of detail for information exchanged.
 - Some clinicians will only need broad (high-level) data communicated, essentially indicating that a concern exists.
 - Others in specialty areas or in care coordination will desire to see more details.
 - The type of transition or part of the care cycle can also influence the specificity of information desired (pre-admission, during admission, post admission).
- Community members presented the slides describing how “Dynamic Value Sets” could be used as an approach to organize domain value sets for Functioning Observations.
- PACIO Leadership shared some examples of possible spreadsheet templates to capture the alignment of the Functional and Cognitive Status ICF concepts with existing items in the post-acute care Data Element Library (DEL). The DEL is available at:

- The group discussed the “levels” of codes in the ICF on which to focus. The current consensus recommendation is to start organizing concepts and

alignments initially at the “three level” codes (e.g., d450), acknowledging that later more specificity may be required.

- The group will continue the discussion in future weeks.
