 - Technical ballot reconciliation discussions occur during the ADI Profile meetings Mondays at 3 pm ET.
 - Tech team leadership presented Block vote 1 to the Patient Empowerment Work Group on 2/17/22; a vote is scheduled on 2/24/22.
- Subgroup leadership shared domain subject matter expert (SME) recommended dispositions to ballot comments on defining search parameters (FHIR-34470). SMEs identified roles performing an ADI search and role-based search criteria to ensure the IG provides appropriate search functionality guidance.

4) **SPLASCH Update** (Brian Meshell and Jamila Harley)

(**S**peech, **L**anguage, **S**wallowing, **C**ognitive **C**ommunication, and **H**earing)

- Subgroup leadership reviewed:
 - LOINC's recent publication (version 2.72) includes five Functional Communication Measures (FCMs) requested by ASHA (American Speech-Language-Hearing Association): spoken language comprehension, spoken language expression, swallowing, multimodal communication, and cognition.
 - SPLASCH subgroup prioritization poll results and identification of future focus areas (aligned to the ICF framework).
 - Priority focus areas not covered by cognitive or functional status IG work:
 - Hearing
 - Multimodal communication (e.g., non-verbal communication, need for assistive communication devices, and other methods)
 - Further exploration of existing LOINC codes related to SPLASCH concepts

5) **May 2022 HL7 Connectathon Use Case** (PACIO Leadership and Community)

- The PACIO track plans to test data sharing across multiple implementation guides (IG), both internal and external to PACIO.
 - PACIO Leadership shared a draft of the Connectathon Use Case and requested feedback.
 - Walked through 8 scenes with a Standard Patient Health Record (SPHR) as a central health data manager repository to assist the patient in sharing her personal data with clinicians and family members.
 - Noted the Use Case covers multiple acute and post-acute healthcare settings and involves a transition from her home state to visiting her son in another state where she unexpectedly requires healthcare treatment.
- A member expressed concern for how clinicians will determine what is important once they begin to receive all the potential data exchanged in the future state.
 - Reminded the community that PACIO's role is to provide the infrastructure to allow data to be exchanged (especially in important content areas that currently lack any standardized data transmission).
 - Concerns for clinician's ability to ingest and make sense of new "floods of data" available to them are valid.



- Implementers may use the standards PACIO develops to design solutions that present the data in effective ways to support clinical decision making.
 - Addressing this need may be how EHR vendors and other implementors excel and distinguish themselves.
 - Data will be most useful if categorized. Some categorizations will come at a high level from the USCDI (US Core Data for Interoperability) data elements and data categories.
 - A member suggested that it might be helpful to identify information that would describe and be considered a “general cognition” or “general function” status.
 - Additional ways to provide structure around data could include using the broader groupings of concepts found within the ICF.
 - A prioritization poll for categories (ICF) needed for Functional and Cognitive Status IGs for STU-2 will be created and distributed in future weeks.
