2) May 2022 HL7 Connectathon Use Case (Karl Naden)

- PACIO Integration track proposal submitted on Tue March 01, 2022
- Track kickoff scheduled for Wed April 27, 2022 at 1:30 pm ET, in place of the usual weekly PACIO meeting
- The PACIO Integration track plans to test data sharing across multiple implementation guides (IG), both internal and external to PACIO.
 - PACIO Leadership shared a draft of the Connectathon Use Case and requested feedback.
 - Walked through 8 scenes with a Standard Patient Health Record (SPHR) as a central health data manager repository to assist the patient in sharing her personal data with clinicians and family members.
 - Noted the Use Case covers multiple acute and post-acute healthcare settings and involves a transition from her home state to visiting her son in another state where she unexpectedly requires healthcare treatment.
- PACIO Leadership invited anyone interested in planning for the Connectathon, especially to test their systems with this integrated use case for data exchange, to join the weekly Tech Team meetings (Thursday 2 -3 pm ET). - Technical ballot reconciliation discussions occur during the ADI Profile meetings Mondays at 3:00 pm ET.
- ADI STU1 ballot reconciliation
 - FHIR-34470 Define Search Parameters. Reviewed default search parameters. Identified roles.
- ADI STU-2 Content Type II & III Practitioner Authored Portable Medical Orders
 - Introduced the adjudication spreadsheet and provided an overview of how the group will use it will to perform an environmental scan of existing forms.

5) Terminology Review (Corey Spears)

- Instead of defining terminology (code systems and value sets) in their individual implementation guides, implementers should use the Terminology Home Page (THO) available at <https://terminology.hl7.org/>
- The new HL7 process for governance and maintenance of the vocabulary is called Unified Terminology Governance (UTG.), it provides a single location for terminology definitions that implementers can use across multiple implementation guides.

6) SPLASCH Update (Brian Meshell and Jamila Harley)

- (Speech, Language, Swallowing, Cognitive Communication, and Hearing)

- Subgroup leadership reviewed:
 - LOINC's recent publication (version 2.72) includes five Functional Communication Measures (FCMs) requested by ASHA (American Speech-Language-Hearing Association): spoken language comprehension, spoken language expression, swallowing, multimodal communication, and cognition.
 - SPLASCH subgroup prioritization poll results and identification of future focus areas (aligned to the International Classification of Functioning (ICF) framework).
 - Priority focus areas not covered by cognitive or functional status IG work:
 - Hearing
 - Multimodal communication (e.g., non-verbal communication, need for assistive communication devices, and other methods)
 - Further exploration of existing LOINC codes related to SPLASCH concepts.
