- PACIO Integration track proposal submitted on Tue March 01, 2022.
- Goal is to finalize the list of participants and roles by the end of the week, Fri March 11, 2022.
- Track kickoff scheduled for Wed April 27, 2022 at 1:30 pm ET, in place of the usual weekly PACIO meeting.
- PACIO Leadership shared a draft of the Connectathon Use Case and requested feedback.
  - Walked through 8 scenes with a Standard Patient Health Record (SPHR) as a central health data manager repository to assist the patient in sharing her personal data with clinicians and family members.
  - Noted the Use Case covers multiple acute and post-acute healthcare settings and involves a transition from her home state to visiting her son in another state where she unexpectedly requires healthcare treatment.

(Speech, Language, Swallowing, Cognitive Communication, and Hearing)

- Based on the SPLASCH prioritization survey results and existing gaps not covered by other PACIO implementation guides, the SPLASCH subgroup has set a goal of creating two new profiles to demo as part of the PACIO Integration track at the May Connectathon.
  - Multimodal Communication (defined in ASHA Functional Communication Measures)
  - Hearing (defined at today's subgroup meeting)
- For next week, we are requesting a clinician with the appropriate domain expertise add a paragraph to PACIO Integration use case with a realistic example about patient Betsy's hearing.
- After the SPLASCH IG and PACIO Integration use case are updated per above, we can generate new SPLASCH sample data to use at the May Connectathon.

- ADI at HIMSS (March 14-18, 2022)
- Technical ballot reconciliation discussions occur during the ADI Profile meetings Mondays at 3:00 pm ET.
- ADI STU-2 Content Type II & III Practitioner Authored Portable Medical Orders
  - Introduced the adjudication spreadsheet and provided an overview of how the group will use it to perform an environmental scan of existing forms.
  - Focus on Model of Meaning rather than Model of Use.
  - Exchange orders and observations to gauge stance on Portable Medical Order data exchange using FHIR

- Functional and Cognitive Status Prioritization Survey sent on Tuesday, March 1, 2022. Closed on Tuesday, March 8, 2022. Received 50 responses.
- Survey's driver is open terminology, i.e. all LOINC codes are currently allowed, even if using a particular LOINC code would be nonsensical.
- Survey's goal is to divide open terminology into subdomains within ICF, then define terminology requirements for each subdomain individually (following Gravity's approach)
- Toileting self-care was chosen as the first such example subdomain.
