 - ADI STU-2 Content Type 2 & 3 Practitioner Authored Portable Medical Orders
 - Reviewed use case diagrams for content type 2 and 3 to identify adjustments to improve accuracy.
 - Reviewed open items from STU-1, and STU-2 discussion points
 - How can we help people move away from paper with our IG?
 - Based on community feedback, update to content type 2 diagram and content type 3 use case.

 - The PACIO Integration track plans to test data sharing across ~8 implementation guides (IG), both internal and external to PACIO.
 - Nine total scenes. First scene focusses on hearing (SPLASCH). Next scenes focused on Re-assessment Timepoints. Later scenes focused on home health, identifying gaps in care with clinical quality measures, Gravity social determinants of health (transportation needs), multiple chronic conditions (diabetes), ADI update with family after Betsy relocates to Michigan.
 - Next goals:
 - Complete changes to implementation guides by March 29, 2022.
 - Generate sample data by April 5, 2022. The process to generate sample data is time-consuming, so keep in mind this date is aggressive.
 - Track kickoff scheduled for Wed April 27, 2022 at 1:30 pm ET, in place of the usual weekly PACIO meeting
 - PACIO Leadership invited anyone interested in planning for the Connectathon, especially to test their systems with this integrated use case for data exchange, to join the weekly Tech Team meetings (Thursday 2 -3 pm ET).  - Subject matter experts have filled out spreadsheet template with multi-modal communication sample data for May 2022 Connectathon.
 - Weekly SPLASCH subgroup meeting on March 29, 2022 focused on reviewing the sample data with two goals:
 - Do the sample data values make clinical sense? (Group consensus was yes, after modifying one multi-modal communication observation value to demonstrate an improvement in patient Betsy's condition.)
 - Do we have all the information required to generate sample FHIR instances for the May Connectathon? (Yes.)
 - Ready to generate new SPLASCH sample data. On schedule for the May Connectathon.

 - Block vote 2. All tickets except one are either persuasive or persuasive with mod. One ticket is non persuasive.



- FHIR-34508: Must support designation for emptyReason. Add invariant requiring equal to power of attorney, patient personal advance care plan, power of attorney and living will.
- FHIR-34819, 34518: Remove redundant extensions for information that is already stored in other locations in FHIR.
- FHIR-34796, 34795: Explain why specific SMART capabilities are required or remove them.
- FHIR-34797: Is support of Consent required or not? The CapabilityExpectation for Consent is being changed from Shall to Should.
- 34798: Shall support Transport Layer Security protocol v1.2 or later.
- FHIR-35077, 35678: Inconsistent profile names, remove “PACIO” in titles and profiles. Common pattern established for Name, ID, Title (see slides for examples.)
- Resolution passed by unanimous vote 20-0-0.
- **Walk on Topics from Members**
 - Discussed name options for the IG we’ve been calling the “Uber IG”
 - PACIO Leadership noted that combining implementation guides for Cognitive Status, Functional Status, and possibly also SPLASCH will require a new IG name
 - The initial suggestion was “PACIO PAC Clinical Care Implementation Guide”.
 - Community members suggested choosing a name that doesn’t include “post-acute” because this IG could be used for more than just post-acute care patients.
 - Possible names:
 - Functional Care? (May lead to circular discussions about what defines functional care.)
 - Clinical Care? (Possibly too broad)
 - Interdisciplinary Functional Care?
 - Functional Determinants of Health – Clinical Care? (possibly the best suggestion so far, but some concerns about an additional “determinants” IG besides Gravity Social Determinants of Health.)
 - Functional Indicators of Clinical Care?
 - Patient-centered Functional Indicators of Clinical Care?
 - Functional Indicators of Health?
