 - Functional Indicators of Health
 - Functional Indicators of Clinical Care
 - Functional Care
- Suggestion for “Functional Performance” received no objections.
- Work on the new IG continues, exploring one value set that combines two code systems.

- Reviewed Connectathon data flow diagram to see how SPLASCH fits into the larger patient story.
- Introduced next step for SPLASCH IG: focus on the remaining concepts in the ASHA functional communication measures (FCM.) Match them with corresponding ICF items.
- SPLASCH implementation guide and sample instances on track for May Connectathon. Will continue to solicit input from subject matter experts as SPLASCH IG development continues.

- Current focus is to complete IG changes and generate sample data.
- The PACIO Integration track plans to test data sharing across ~8 implementation guides (IG), both internal and external to PACIO.
- Six main sections (nine total scenes/sub-scenes) including:
 - Focus on hearing (SPLASCH)
 - Focus on a fall/ankle injury (Re-assessment Timepoints)
 - Focus on home health with diabetes control, identifying gaps in care with clinical quality measures
 - Focus on social determinants of health: transportation needs (Gravity), and multiple chronic conditions (diabetes) (eCare Plan)
 - ELTSS. Update ADI with family after Betsy relocates to Michigan.
 - Focus on a new provider's ability to obtain the full patient history.
