This working group is a public forum and therefore all information shared will be publicly available.

Summary

1) Leadership Update (Dave Hill)

- Shared timeline showing development of the PACIO implementation guides.
- Upcoming events:
 - FHIR Dev Days
 - June 6-9, 2022, Hybrid (virtual and Cleveland, OH)
 - Can still register, but early bird deadline was May 6.
 - Nancy Lush and Dave Hill will present PACIO use case.
 - July 2022 CMS Connectathon
 - PACIO ADI is one of the 12 tracks being featured.
 - ADI STU-1 patient-authored information, and ADI STU-2 practitioner-authored information.
 - Format will be different from previous Connectathons. Will be more focused on demonstrations: three 20-minute demo sessions. Will need to test before Connectathon to ensure successful demo in this limited time.
 - Zero cost to participate.
 - Registration deadline extended to June 30.
 - Thank you to Leah Allen and Jessica Skopac for leading a great conversation at last week's listening session. Will deliver a report June 8.

2) July Connectathon Advance Directives Information (ADI) track (Corey Spears)

- Connectathon registration survey shows that 80-90% of registrants are observers, as opposed to participants.
- This Connectathon will be more focused on demonstrations (three 20-minute demo sessions.)
 - Compared to previous Connectathons with build, test, validate sessions where participants hacked away, this will require more upfront work to ensure a successful demo in limited time.
 - PACIO ADI track has been doing this upfront testing all along, so we are well-prepared.
- July 20, 2022, schedule broken into four sessions, including session 2, which consists of three 20-minute implementer demos. In total, all 4 sessions will take about half a day. Faster and more focused than previous Connectathons. See slide linked above for full schedule.

- Soliciting additional participants for July Connectathon
- Goals vs. Intervention Preferences vs. Observations, possible unintended consequences of using Goal or Intervention resource
- STU-2 environmental scan indicates differences that may not be immediately obvious (example: using gender vs. sex vs. pronouns.)
- Goal is always to get the right information to the right people at the right time
- Consensus: A person's wish not to receive CPR should be represented as an ADI goal (not a clinical goal.)

4) SPLASCH (Brian Meshell)

- (Speech, Language, Swallowing, Cognitive Communication, Hearing)

- New or updated LOINC codes were approved, will be published in Aug. version 2.7.3
 - 100354-0 Frequency of participating in multi-modal communication without assistance.
 - 100355-7 Frequency of participating in spoken language expression communication without assistance.
 - LL6183-9 Answer list updated to include wording and percentage values, normative binding.
- This week's SPLASCH subgroup meeting continued the ongoing effort to map SPLASCH-related concepts to the ICF with the goal of developing value sets to submit to VSAC that will be used by the Functional Performance IG.



- Mapping spreadsheet is available in Box (see Functional Performance update below for more information.).
- Reached group consensus on mapping 21 of the 67 concepts that were identified as SPLASCH-related. Steady progress. Will continue this effort at future SPLASCH subgroup meetings.

5) Re-Assessment Timepoints (Karl Naden)

- Search parameter combination resolution
 - Many negative ballots because no defined search parameter combinations in the capability statement FHIR-35156
 - Underlying community differences on whether primary responsibility for search filtering should be done on FHIR clients or servers.
 - Agreed on goal of clarifying requirements for both clients and servers
 - Search parameters that are supported individually should also be supported in combination (should, i.e., not a hard requirement).
- Clinical Impression clarifications
 - Issue FHIR-35123 use of Clinical Impression extension is unclear.
 - Proposal on clarifying language and content ready for CBCP Work Group.
- Block vote 2 review
 - Proposing the two issues above (FHIR-35156, FHIR-35123) be brought to a vote on the CBCP work group call on June 14, 2022
- Resolution passed by unanimous vote 17-0-0

6) Functional Performance (Lynda Hoeksema, Dave Hill)

- Provided an overview of the mapping spreadsheet.
 - Searched Data Element Library (DEL) for items that are functional performance related.
 - Added columns for identifying closest equivalent ICF item(s).
 - Explained SPLASCH examples where concept maps to several ICF items.
- Resumed mapping Functional Performance concepts to ICF items, using the mapping spreadsheet.
- Started with BIMS (Brief Interview for Mental Status) questions.
- Remainder of the weekly PACIO meeting was a group effort to continue mapping Functional Performance concepts to ICF items.
- Suggestion to rename Functional Performance IG to the Functioning IG. Will not rename the IG immediately but will continue to discuss at next weekly PACIO meeting.
