1) Leadership Update (Dave Hill)

- Shared timeline showing development of the PACIO implementation guides. See leadership slides for the full timelines.
- American Medical Informatics Association (AMIA) accepted PACIO panel presentation
 - November 5-9, 2022 in Washington, DC
 - PACIO panel presentation 60 minutes. Presenters include Lorraine Wickiser CMS sponsor, and PACIO leadership.
 - Selected from a large field of submissions for a small number of slots (about 10% acceptance rate).
- July 2022 CMS Connectathon
 - PACIO ADI track will focus on testing and exchange of ADI information.
 - ADI STU-1 patient-authored information and ADI STU-2 practitioner-authored information.
 - Format will be different from previous Connectathons. Will be more focused on demonstrations: three 20-minute demo sessions. Will need to test before Connectathon to ensure successful demo in this limited time.
 - Zero cost to participate.
 - Registration deadline is June 30, 2022.



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- Connectathon will be 3-day event:
 - July 19: CMS regulation and policy
 - July 20: Track demo/testing (three 20 min sessions)
 - July 21: Track highlights. PACIO scheduled from 2:40 to 3:00 pm.

2) ADI Track Use Case for July 2022 Connectathon (Corey Spears)

- Focus areas:
 - STU 1 – Person authored data
 - STU 2 – Portable Medical Orders (scanned document)
- CarePlan.addresses for conditions the patient currently. Hypothetical future problems should populate text in CarePlan.addresses.display.
- Require Care Plan title
- New Areas:
 - Communication of Portable Medical Order (PMO)
 - Add the existence of the PMO in the PACP
- Connectathon use case supports both scanned paper documents and structured documents. See slides for full timeline of use case scenes.
 - Scene 0 sets the scene
 - Scene 1 create PMO
 - Scene 2 update PACP
 - Scene 3 update Michigan power of attorney and living will
 - Scene 4 retrieval of ADI information
- Next steps: finalize participants, update reference implementation

- STU-2 environmental scan: LOINC codes requested for National POLST form
- Plans to discover the rationale used by the CDA ePOLST group when requesting new LOINC codes.
- Invited Community members to review the Environmental Scan Workbook and continue to review as it evolves.

4) SPLASCH (Brian Meshell)

- Continued ongoing effort to map SPLASCH concepts onto the ICF.
- Discussions revolved around how many levels deep into the ICF hierarchy to go to capture swallowing related items with the correct level of specificity.
- Successfully mapped 48 of the 67 concepts that were identified as SPLASCH related.
- Subject matter experts requested assistance from a dietician for the items dealing with weight gain or loss, which comprise most of the remaining items.
 - Community members offered to put them in touch with dieticians who can provide input on these remaining items.

6) Functioning IG (formerly Functional Performance) (Karl Naden)

- Goal is to focus on mobility and self-care to see if there is value in mapping them at more specific level in the ICF
- Make information understandable to clinicians, restrict the possible space of responses to make information useful.
- Start with section G of the MDS: mobility
- Continued mapping mobility and self-care MDS items onto the ICF. Mapping spreadsheet is available in Box.
- A community member express concern with mapping the G items as they will be replaced by Section GG items later this year.
