Summary

1) Leadership Update (Dave Hill)

- July 2022 CMS Connectathon
 - Information session was held on June 8, 2022
 - PACIO ADI track will focus on testing and exchange of ADI information
 - ADI STU-1 patient-authored information, and ADI STU-2 practitioner-authored information.
 - Format will be different from previous Connectathons. Will be more focused on demonstrations: three 20-minute demo sessions. Will need to test before Connectathon to ensure successful demo in this limited time.
 - Zero cost to participate.
 - Registration deadline is June 30, 2022.
 - Connectathon will be 3-day event:
 - July 19: CMS regulation and policy
 - July 20: Track demo/testing (three 20 min sessions)
 - July 21: Track highlights. PACIO scheduled from 2:40 to 3:00 pm.
 - AMIA Conference panel was accepted
 - Panel is November 5-9, 2022, in Washington DC
 - PACIO panel presentation 90 minutes
 - CMS and PACIO leadership

2) Functioning IG naming (Dave Hill)

- HL7 says our previous attempts at names (functioning, human functioning) are too broad



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- Need a name that will allow a layperson (not a clinician, ICF expert, or FHIR IG author) to understand what the IG represents
- Suggestion to use the word “engagement” which doesn’t have a specific meaning in FHIR or ICF.
- Discussion around which names to eliminate and how to order the names remaining on the list
- List of possible names to present to FHIR Management Group (ranked roughly in order or preference by the participants on this weekly PACIO call):
 1. Personal Functioning and Engagement
 2. Personal Functioning, Activities and Participation
 3. Personal Functioning Performance and Capacity
 4. Personal Functioning Performance and Engagement
 5. Personal Functioning Performance, Capacity, and Engagement
 6. Personal Functioning Performance, Capacity, and Participation
 7. Personal Functioning, Activities of Daily Living, and Participation
 8. Functional Performance and Capacity
 9. Human Functioning
 10. Human Functioning Performance and Capacity

3) Re-Assessment Timepoints (Karl Naden)

- STU1 Ballot Reconciliation Block Vote 3 includes minor wording changes as well as more substantive updates to the IG.
- See slides linked above for a full list of issues. A subset of the substantive changes is described below:
 - Distinguish Re-Assessment Timepoint the IG vs Re-assessment Timepoint the FHIR profile (note capitalization.)
 - Security and privacy: Re-write general considerations section to indicate clinical information should be protected. Point to FHIR community resources that may be used, but do not recommend any specific one.
 - Add a use case page with potential usage patterns for clients, based on previous Connectathons.
- Karl made a motion to accept the items for Block vote 3, Ken Harwood seconded. Motion passed with a vote of 24-0-0.

4) ADI STU1 Profile Terminology Review (Corey Spears)

- Terminology review tiger team (see slides for full list of team members).
- Conducted a cross specification review FHIR ADI & CDA PACP & CDA ePOLST.
- Compared 34 ValueSets, with more than 750 codes.
- ValueSet Authority Center (VSAC) manages value sets used by various IGs, including U.S. Core.
- Examples of ValueSets to move to VSAC:
 - Participant Role
 - Advance Directive Document Type (aka categories)
 - Care, experience, preferences
 - Participant relationships
- Model changes in FHIR ADI because FHIR was developed largely by clinicians, and goals/preferences are not necessarily clinical in nature.
- ADI leadership stressed the importance of PACIO implementation guides to provide glidepaths for EHR vendors to share data between healthcare settings. Commended MITRE for doing the work to make it easier to adopt HL7.

5) SPLASCH (Brian Meshell)

- Weekly SPLASCH subgroup call, discussed possible names for the new IG (formerly called Functioning IG) that will include SPLASCH concepts.
 - Took a first pass at generating the list of potential names reviewed at this meeting (see Functioning Naming above)
- Continued ongoing effort of mapping SPLASCH-related concepts onto the ICF to create value sets for new IG.
- Two dietitians recommended by PACIO member joined SPLASCH subgroup to provide expertise for mapping concepts related to weight gain/loss.

7) Functioning IG value set ICF mapping (Karl Naden)

- Resumed ongoing effort of mapping concepts onto the ICF with the goal of creating value sets for Functioning IG.
