- Shared timeline showing development of the PACIO implementation guides.
- July 2022 CMS Connectathon (only 2 weeks away!)
  - Registration closed on June 30, 2022.
  - Information session was held on June 8, 2022.
  - PACIO ADI track will focus on testing and exchange of ADI information
  - ADI STU-1 patient-authored information, and the transmission of a scanned practitioner-authored document.
  - Format will be different from previous Connectathons. Will be more focused on demonstrations: three 20-minute demo sessions. Will need to test before Connectathon to ensure successful demo in this limited time.
  - Connectathon will be 3-day event:
    - July 19: CMS regulation and policy
    - July 20: Track demo/testing
    - July 21: Track highlights. PACIO scheduled from 2:40 to 3:00 pm.
  - AMIA Conference panel was accepted
    - Panel is Nov 5-9, 2022, in Washington DC
    - PACIO presentation 90 minutes
    - CMS sponsor and MITRE PACIO leadership

- Multiple relationships to consider when deciding on the model to adopt (physician, nurse practitioner, professional assisting patient with form completion, etc.).
- Environmental scan in progress (31 forms have been deconstructed).
- There is value in capturing the practitioner role.

## 3) SPLASCH (Brian Meshell)

- Introduced the ICF mapping effort for newcomers and subject matter experts who have not joined the SPLASCH subgroup call regularly.
- Continued ongoing effort of mapping SPLASCH-related concepts onto the ICF to create value sets for new IG with a focus on items related to nutrition and weight, to take advantage of dietitians' expertise.
  - In general, for assessment items dealing with nutrition, weight, and eating unassisted, included functions related to the digestive system plus additional categories from elsewhere in the ICF.
  - For items dealing with intake by artificial route, included only relevant subcategories.

## 4) Re-assessment Timepoints (Karl Naden)

- No subgroup meeting this week. In a holding pattern, awaiting completion of block vote in CBCP workgroup.
  - Have proposed resolutions for all tickets.
  - Block vote expected to take place at next CPCP workgroup meeting, or the following one.
