Summary

1) Personal Functioning and Engagement (PFE) IG Update (Karl Naden)

- Bringing together cognitive status, functional status, SPLASCH. Common structure. Currently observation-focused, but will eventually expand to include other resource types.
- Domain-based terminology framework with common value sets under the umbrella PFE IG.
- The PFE IG provides the structure. The supplemental guide provides the domains and terminology.
- Re-established the cognitive and functional status subgroup.
- Four main roles of subgroups that contribute to PFE:
 - Define the scope of subgroup through use cases
 - Provide structural requirements for the PFE FHIR IG
 - Define and maintain one or more domains and related value sets within the supplemental guide
 - Support testing and piloting activities
- The PFE FHIR standard is only a small piece that fits into a larger context where our goal is communication to facilitate care and decision making.



- Next steps:
 - Engage with subgroups
 - Ballot reconciliation: resolve comments, publish STU1

2) **SPLASCH Update** (Brian Meshell)

- Speech, Language, Swallowing, Cognitive Communication, Hearing
- Aligning with the PFE subgroup roles.
- Worked to define goals, processes, and expected contributions.
- Provided expectations for the subgroup roles contributing to the PFE, including goals and processes”
- One important reframing is that we will start by defining our use cases (scenarios) that will drive the rest of our SPLASCH-related work: (IG development, domains, value sets, etc.)
- Better defined the subgroup meeting structure: Start and end each meeting with the agenda:
 - At the start, introduce today’s agenda topics.
 - At the end, create the agenda for next week.
 - All participants are empowered to add agenda topics either at the subgroup meeting or throughout the week via email.
- Next subgroup call will focus on brainstorming scenarios that will drive the rest of our work, including pilot opportunities.

3) **Cognitive Status and Functional Status Update** (Karl Naden)

- The first subgroup meeting for the newly re-formed Cognitive and Functional Status subgroup was this morning.
- Clarice Grote is the subgroup lead.
- Subgroup meeting included a presentation to define the subgroup roles, goals, and processes.

4) **Re-Assessment Timepoints IG Update** (Karl Naden)

- Exciting news: as of today, the Re-Assessment Timepoints IG has officially been published as STU1. Thank you to all our contributors!
- Still looking for implementers pilot opportunities. If you are interested in participating in a pilot, please reach out to Karl Naden.

5) **ADI subgroup Update** (Maria Moen / Corey Spears)

- Provided an overview of the HL7 Work Group Meeting and USCDI v4 comments.
- The in-person event provided an opportunity to connect with industry and HL7 leadership including Grahame Grieve.



- Encouraged participants to attend the in-person January 2023 Connectathon in Las Vegas.
- At the subgroup meeting, a community member encouraged ADI to consider the work done to protect a patient's right to their genetic information.
- Environmental scan: completed 81 form reviews. Reviewed LOINC codes from the ePOLST CDA project.
- Solicited ADI community feedback on the proposed USCDI v4 comments. The community supports the submission of USCDI v4 comments.
- Ballot reconciliation in progress. Tickets include:
 - Definition of "must support"
 - Which elements are required?
 - Search parameters, as defined in capability statement

6) ADI USCDI v4 Comments (Maria Moen)

- Already reviewed comments on Encounter, Functional Status, Mental/Cognitive Status, Disability Status at last week's PACIO meeting.
- Today will focus on USCDI v4 comments that are specific to ADI.
- Provenance data class: support moving author data element into Provenance (currently author is level 2.).
- PACIO's focus has been on "model of meaning" as opposed to "model of use."
- Provide information about the various types of Advance Directives information:
 - Type I: Patient-Authored
 - Type II: Practitioner-Authored
 - Type III: Orders for Life-Sustaining Treatment
- We would like the Advance Directive data class to move to USCDI level 2.
- Modify "Durable Medical Power of Attorney" to "Healthcare Agent" and advance to USCDI level 2.
- Modify "Living Will" to "Priorities Under Certain Health Conditions" and "Priorities Upon Death" to distinguish patient's wishes from the legal document "Living Will."
- Promote "Care Experience Preferences" to USCDI level 2.
- Promote "Advance Directives Observation" to USCDI level 2.
- Advance "Orders for End of Life Care" to USCDI v4.

7) Leadership Update (Dave Hill)

- Reminder that USCDI v4 comments are due Sept 30, 2022. Guidance is to focus on comments for existing elements before requesting new ones.
- No change to PACIO use cases except the good news that Re-Assessment Timepoints has been published.
