Summary

1) Leadership Update (Dave Hill)

- PACIO submitted 11 pages of comments for USCDI v4. Comments were due Sept 30, 2022. Big thank you to all who contributed.
- Re-Assessment Timepoints Implementation Guide (IG) has been published.

- January 2023 HL7 Connectathon and Work Group Meeting:
 - In-person at Hilton Lake Las Vegas Resort and Spa, Henderson, Nevada
 - Connectathon is Jan 14-15, 2023. PACIO will have a track.
 - WG meeting Jan 16-20, 2023

2) ADI Update (Maria D. Moen)

- At weekly ADI subgroup meeting, reviewed the results of environmental scan (LOINC code, long description/attributes, standardized codes to review, form full description.)



- Portable Medical Orders are in effect until superseded by another medical order.
- Artificially administered nutrition was included on National POLST form to ease into difficult conversations (Many prefer to lead with nutrition).
- Environmental scan compared the identified LOINC codes to CDA ePOLST codes. Noted that a document type is used differently than an order panel.

3) SPLASCH Update (Brian Meshell)

- Weekly subgroup call focused on brainstorming scenarios for exchanging SPLASCH data within the PFE IG.
- Started the subgroup meeting by sharing the use case and data flow diagram from the January 2022 Connectathon to give an example scenario.
- Instead of creating a totally new scenario, the group brainstormed ways to expand the existing scenario where our patient Betsy suffers a stroke and transitions among care settings.
- Possible scenes to add to existing scenario:
 - IRF (Inpatient Rehab Facility)
 - Transition of Care (TOC) visit with PCP (Sockalow paper)
 - Mobile MRI or CAT scan done onsite by paramedics
- Next weekly subgroup call will pick up where this conversation left off. Now that we have some possible organizations, we will brainstorm what data to exchange from one organization to the next.

4) Functional Status and Cognitive Status (Clarice Grote)

- This week was the second subgroup meeting for the newly re-established Functional Status and Cognitive Status subgroup.
- Discussed goals and identified key data elements for function and cognition that are important for transitions of care.
- Initial use case will be a patient with a severe stroke. Will align with SPLASCH and possibly other IGs.

5) Personal Functioning and Engagement (PFE) IG Update (Karl Naden)

- This week there was no subgroup meetings specific to PFE. Instead, PFE will be informed by the discussions at the SPLASCH and functional / cognitive status subgroups.
- Ballot reconciliation from September ballot. Areas to discuss:
 - Official ICF code system
 - Organization of (nested hierarchical) collections
 - Technical terminology details
- Plan to discuss guidance around PFE domains.

6) Physical Activity IG (Paul Chase)



- Will host a virtual IG test event in late October or early November 2022 (exact date TBD.)
- Submitted physical activity assessment (Exercise Vital Sign and Muscle-Strengthening Question) to the USCDI.
- Meeting with American College of Sports Medicine (framework for exercise referral and reimbursement.)
- Project updates:
 - Consensus on primary measure: Exercise vital sign. Number of days per week of muscular strength exercise.
 - Establishing list of supporting measures (derived from wearable activity trackers, or self-reported.)
