Summary

1) Leadership Update (Dave Hill)

- No change to use case timelines. Status of the PACIO use cases:
 - Functional Status, Cognitive Status, Re-assessment Timepoints all published as STU1
 - ADI has a two-pronged approach. STU1 is in ballot reconciliation, STU2 in IG development
 - PFE just entered ballot reconciliation
- AMIA Conference Presentation:
 - American Medical Informative Association
 - November 5-9, 2022 in Washington DC
 - Anticipating over 2022 attendees, new audience for PACIO
 - PACIO panel presentation “The Future is Now: Enabling Greater Post-Acute Care Interoperability” November 9, 2022 from 8:30 to 10:00 AM (Eastern)
- January 2023 HL7 Connectathon and Work Group Meeting:
 - In-person at Hilton Lake Las Vegas Resort and Spa, Henderson, Nevada
 - Connectathon is January 14-15, 2023; PACIO will have a track
 - WG meeting January 16-20, 2023

2) Impressions from AHCA, NASL (Advion) & NCAL Conference

- Lantana gave a presentation at NASL / Advion about Interoperability.
- Genice will follow up with Lantana to see if they can share their presentation with the larger PACIO community.
- Good crossover, opportunities to ask for pilot implementers.
- Interesting to learn about the history of health interoperability.

3) ADI Update (Maria D. Moen)

- Subgroup discussion focused on Connectathon planning for ADI track at January 2023 Connectathon.
- Reviewed target use cases and proposed data flow.
- Discovered variations in how each state manages their AD/ACP/PMO registry and repository.
- Data flow will rely on a single source of truth.
- Reviewed issued with voiding a portable medical order.
- Get the word out to potential participants in January 2023 Connectathon.

4) Physical Activity IG (Paul Chase)

- Virtual test event pushed back to end of November or beginning of December
Will nail down date at next meeting on October 20.
- Had a productive meeting with Gravity to capitalize on the work they've done so far.
- Working with the Digital Medicine Society on their "Core Measures of Physical Activity."
- Established list of supporting measures to get from wearable fitness trackers and connected exercise equipment.
- Hope to move on to the Diagnosis and Referral portion of the IG in a week or two.

5) SPLASCH Update (Brian Meshell)

- At the weekly subgroup meeting on Monday, continued building patient scenario for use in pilot opportunities.
- Explored possible ways to expand Betsy's patient story.
- Added a new scene: Inpatient rehab facility (IRF) between acute care hospital and skilled nursing facility (SNF.)
- Documented Betsy's medical history, symptoms following a severe stroke, medical imaging and other assessments ordered.
- In working toward a pilot, we should avoid asking implementers to change their practice because this is a barrier to implementation.



6) Functional Status and Cognitive Status (Clarice Grote)

- Scheduled HH to PCP for transition of care visit use case discussion scheduled for November 2, 2022.
- Use case demo by Patient Centric Solutions for self-care, mobility, cognition, and SPLASCH data.
- Presentation on PFE pushed to next week.
- Requested members notify interested parties to attend conversation on November 2.
- Discussed opportunities to expand this type of use case and the need to involve EMR and EHR companies in the conversation.
- Reviewed how this data is currently used, how it can be used in clinics.

7) Personal Functioning and Engagement (PFE) IG Update (Karl Naden)

- PFE ballot reconciliation.
- FHIR-38618 Clarity on why the terms personal and engagement are in the IG title. Opened discussion to the group: What is this IG trying to convey in terms of scope and data?
- Several participants gave descriptions along the lines of: how a person functions in their daily life and engages with the world.
- We want to update the description of PFE IG and review it with the group at a future weekly PACIO call.
- Will handle PFE ballot comments on a case-by-case basis. May discuss non-technical comments like this one at weekly PACIO calls.
