Summary

1) PACIO Leadership Update (Dave Hill)

- No change to PACIO use case timelines.
 - Advance Directives (ADI) ballot reconciliation for STU-1, IG development for STU-2.
 - Personal Functioning and Engagement (PFE) ballot reconciliation, only 4 negative comments.
- American Medical Informatics Association (AMIA) conference:
 - November 5-9, 2022, in Washington DC.
 - PACIO panel presentation. “The Future is Now: Enabling Greater Post-Acute Care Interoperability” November 9, 2022, at 8:30-10:00 am ET.
- January 2023 HL7 Connectathon and Work Group Meeting:
 - In-person, Henderson, NV.
 - Connectathon is January 14-15, 2023. PACIO will have a track: ADI STU-2 (POLST exchange).
 - Work Group Meeting January 16-20, 2023.
 - Registration opens December 1; early bird registration deadline is December 16.



2) ADI Update (Maria D. Moen)

- Provided a Connectathon update. Emailed a request for Connectathon participants (EMR, EHR, state registry, etc.)
- At previous Connectathons, tested the exchange of person-authored information. This Connectathon will test practitioner-authored portable medical orders.
- STU-2 environmental scan: continued review of ePOLST CDA codes
 - Need guidance on codes 100821-8 National POLST form code for panel vs. 93037-0 code for document type
 - 100822-6 CPR Orders need to assess relationship to STU-2 structures
 - LL6263-9 Preferred Answer List. Some items have the same preferred answer list as National POLST form, others do not
 - National POLST form includes both discrete and narrative text
- Canceled November 9 ADI subgroup meeting due to conflict with AMIA conference

3) Physical Activity Update (Paul Chase)

- Virtual Test Event planned for December 2, 2022. Expect 2-3 participants, need to confirm.
- Application to ONC USCDI received level 1, open for comment. Trying to resubmit to get one or two areas elevated to level 2, which would bring aggregate score to level 2.
- Digital Medicine Society's Core Measures of Physical Activity generated interest in our work, specifically Google is interested.
- Next Tuesday (November 8, 2022) White House Conference, follow up from last month. They are interested in gathering information on Physical Activity IG.
- No subgroup meeting on Tuesday November 8, 2022.
- Project update: prioritizing supportive measures, connected exercise equipment and wearable activity trackers to verify individuals are participating in moderate to vigorous exercise.

4) SPLASCH Update (Brian Meshell)

- Continued to expand Betsy's patient story for use in pilot opportunities.
- Leadership thanked community for their contributions.
- Worked backwards through the scenes in Betsy's care journey, thinking about what information the providers at each step would want.
- Focused specifically on the transition of care from home health to assisted living facility.



- Assisted living facility will want information on Betsy's comprehension, expression, swallowing, diet, hearing, motor speech, cognitive communication skills, orientation to time, place, staff, routine/schedule, safety.
- Next week's SPLASCH subgroup meeting will focus on brainstorming participants for pilot opportunities.
- Requested the group If you know of any potential participants who might be interested in a pilot, please reach out to Brian Meshell and Inoka Tennakoon.

5) Functional Status and Cognitive Status (Clarice Grote)

- At weekly Functional and Cognitive Status subgroup meeting, met with Dr. Paulina Sockolow to discuss home health to PCP communication.
- The use case focuses on 33 items from OASIS.
- Looking for individuals excited about this use case. Will schedule a follow up call.
- Discussed barriers including the cost from EHRs to build new interfaces (some EHRs charge \$10,000, which can be cost-prohibitive).
- OASIS items sometimes provide scores without context, so they can have limited use.
- Section GG may provide a better framework as it is more consistent.
- Need home health agencies and vendors who are interested in testing or demoing this work. How can we incentivize them?

6) Personal Functioning and Engagement (PFE) IG Update (Karl Naden)

- Working on technical aspects of the PFE IG.
- Today will be a continuation of last week's discussion of the IG's scope and boundaries.
- The goal of an IG is to enable communication of health information between those involved in the provision of care.
- Want to discuss the relationship of PFE to other IGs because there is some overlap in scope.
- Proposed that observations that could fall under PFE but are already covered by other IGs should be considered outside our scope. (Examples: heart rate, red blood cell count.)
- An optimal strategy is to stick as close to U.S. Core as possible, layer additional LTPAC information on U.S. Core as necessary (example: assistive devices.)
- What does PFE add? Categories recommended terminology: code systems and value sets.
