 - The PACIO Project's proposed disposition is: "Not Persuasive with Modification."
 - The rationale for keeping the name Personal Functioning and Engagement (PFE) is detailed in the slides linked above.
 - PACIO recommends keeping the name and adding an explanation to the PFE IG introductory text.



- Because there has been contention around the PFE IG's name, Dave Hill suggested calling a formal vote.
 - Karl Naden made a motion to close FHIR-38618 with disposition "Not Persuasive with Modification."
 - Ken Harwood seconded.
 - Motion passed with a vote of 23-0-0.

 - Context for this discussion: A comment was submitted to align the PFE IG with Gravity Social Determinants of Health (SDOH) use of the Method element within the Observation resource to collect the mechanism used to perform the Observation and who performed it, Community agreed that the information is pertinent to our data. NCQA requires race and ethnicity is require for the equity requirement.
