- Dave Hill presented a proposal for categorization support in the STU1 version of the PFE IG:
 - Technical: Provide specific guidance around technical categories used to tie observation codes to domains that drive conformance requirements, including a specific process for assigning categories to observation codes.
 - Clinical: Support more detailed clinical categorization using ICF but provide no guidance on its use within this version.
- Tina Wilkins made a motion to accept Dave's proposal. Clarice Grote seconded. Vote passed 16-0-0.
