This will give you until March 31st to complete your IG, but it must be delivered to the sponsoring Work Group for QA review and sign off</li> </ul> </li> <li>• April 2 - QA period ends</li> <li>• April 3 -5 - apply final QA</li> <li>• April 6-7 - complete Ballot Readiness Checklist and submit</li> <li>• April 10 - Ballot opens</li> </ul>
