## Catalog Updates (John Hatem)

- October 26, 2020
  - no updates still working on ballot reconciliation
- October 19, 2020
  - working on ballot reconciliation
- October 5, 2020 - Discussion with Catalogue Project Team
  - [20201005\\_Pharmacy\\_WG\\_catalogs.pptx](#)
  - FHIR IG Project
    - see slide deck for more information
    - Pharmacy is a co-sponsor for this project
    - Guidance for implementing catalogues
      - laboratory services - PlanDefinition
      - drugs - MedicationKnowledge
      - devices - DeviceDefinition
      - Order sets - PlanDefinition
    - Balloted in September as STU - lab content only - passed
      - working on ballot reconciliation
    - Tested in last 2 connectathons on lab content
      - lab service is like a plan of activity - supported by PlanDefinition
        - also uses other resources - use PlanDefinition to connect these resources
    - so far, the scope has been for use by practitioners, may need to be updated when we start with medications
      - for lab it is practitioners
    - Next steps -
      - resolve ballot comments
      - specify other kinds of catalogues - use cases, specification, artifacts, examples
      - devices, medications, order sets
    - PHAST - Medication content
      - Use Case 1 - Master catalog of medications for jurisdiction
        - all drugs that can be ordered within a country
        - catalogue provided to each organization - all applications can import into their own dictionary
      - Use Case 2 - Healthcare organization drug formulary
        - healthcare organization maintains its drug formulary and shares it to the applications used by practitioners
        - could also be from outside of the organization
      - Use Case 3 - Combination of use cases 1 and 2
        - synchronize the 2
      - MedicationKnowledge plus ClinicalUseIssue - seem to fulfill the 3 uses cases in terms of content
      - Question - will MedicationKnowledge and ClinicalUseIssue will be in R4B?
        - want current state
        - R4B will be a technical correction of R4 plus MedicationDefinition and Evidence Resources
          - will not include updates to MedicationKnowledge
          - Should MedicationKnowledge be included in R4B?
          - If there is urgency for this, suggest a tracker be created - separate issue for the 2 different resources
      - segmentation of formulary is a requirement
      - we have a patient perspective on the use cases
      - Pharmacy has worked on use cases - Melva will send the use cases to Francois
      - PDex - built to support ONC rules - allowing patient the capability to see what the drugs will be covered
      - there may be use cases coming out of Unicom
      - Next steps
        - consolidate use cases
        - Will come back to Pharmacy once ballot reconciliation is complete for lab
  - September 14, 2020 - no meeting today
  - September 4, 2020
    - Prep for upcoming Connectathon discussed
    - Confirmed attendance at upcoming Pharmacy WGM
    - Rob H shared he had a contact (no name mentioned) that was interested in working on a Medication catalog. Rob did state he told them to reach out to Pharmacy for follow up.

      - transaction to convey additional information
      - working to gather requirements
      - participated in connectathons
      - looking for additional implementer feedback
      - users of this guide - pharmacy systems involved in fulfilling a specialty prescription; a specialty hub; other party
      - data source system would be an EHR associated with system that generated the prescription
      - Using Messaging
      - Next steps
        - Plans to submit to NCPDP to get feedback from stakeholders in November
        - will drive next steps
        - NIB deadline for HL7 is November 1, 2020
        - will come back to Pharmacy WG on next weeks call
  - September 14, 2020
    - Connectathon last week
    - had pharmacies, EHR and hubs represented
    - didn't get as much technical feedback as was hoped
    - didn't have participation with a mock application or an actual implementation to validate
    - Balloting in January 2021 is to be determined
  - August 24, 2020
    - hoping to submit voting item for November voting cycle at NCPDP
    - hope to incorporate comments in January HL7 ballot
    - hope to bring to HL7 after Connectathon
    - need to bring content to Pharmacy WG for review
  - August 10, 2020
    - Implementation Guide - making progress
    - plan to participate in September Connectathon
    - schedule a review of IG when ready
  - August 3, 2020
    - no updates
  - July 27, 2020
    - have Connectathon track for September
- Finished external code system requirements for HTA - signed off on this by NCPDP
  - will be added to hl7.Terminology.org
- Standardized Medication List - [Standardized Medication Profile](#)
  - October 26, 2020
    - Confluence page has been updated with November Task Group details
    - White paper not completed, but it is getting close
  - October 19, 2020
    - Still working on white paper
    - Scott will look into it
  - October 5, 2020
    - no discussion
  - September 14, 2020 - no update
  - August 24, 2020
    - still writing the White Paper
    - you need to have an account
    - will come back to Pharmacy after completing the White Paper
    - Action: need to determine plans for the project at HL7 with respect to ballot
  - August 10, 2020
    - meeting in August is cancelled
    - next meeting September 2
  - August 3, 2020
    - next meeting is August 19 - working on White Paper
  - July 27, 2020
    - next meeting will be in August
- MTM - create FHIR IG
  - October 26, 2020

## DaVinci PDex Formulary Project

- October 26, 2020 - Publication Request (if received from Dave)
  - Changes have been completed
  - Some changes have not been pushed
  - CMS wanted this published by the end of October
  - Dave will send updated IG
  - Publication Request has been created
    - will include on next weeks agenda
- October 19, 2020
  - Technical Correction Items (Dave Hill)
    - there are 4 Jira issues for discussion
    - in current IG - daVinci is capitalized and not capitalized
      - converted all to lower case to be consistent with other daVinci IGs
    - conversion to new FHIR IG template -
    - error in index page for search queries - spelling mistake to be fixed
    - Zip files - use of upper case "D" on daVinci
      - converted to lower case
  - Motion to approve the disposition of the 4 Jira Issues: FHIR-28361, 23127, 28362, 28494
    - Moved by Scott - seconded by Dave Hill - 10-0-0 Carried
  - Need approval from Pharmacy and then FMG and TSC
  - Will need to vote on a publication - Dave will create and then come back to Pharmacy

  - plan for ballot in May 2021
  - Connectathon in January 2021
  - asking Pharmacy to be a co-sponsor
  - interested in knowing what medications patients who are hospitalized with Covid are on - inpatient medications
    - name
    - formulation and route
    - start/stop date
    - Dose
    - medication identifier
  - Pharmacy was not asked to be a sponsor - there was a push to get the PSS submitted
  - Discussion of mapping of fields needed
  - Motion to approve Pharmacy as a sponsor - Sarah Gaunt - John Hatem - 10-0-0 Carried
